

Academic Program

Uta Halee Day School works in collaboration with our students, their families and home school districts to provide an academic experience that meets all of their unique and varying needs.

Academic classes are aligned to the student's Individual Education Plan (IEP) as well as the home school district's graduation requirements.

Teachers are qualified special education instructors and follow all IEPs, document and report progress and provide approved accommodations.

Gender-Specific Programming

Researchers have found substantial evidence supporting the idea that girls and boys experience learning differently. Uta Halee Day School caters to this discrepancy in learning styles and needs by offering a gender-specific academic program that specifically targets the needs of female students.

Classrooms are organized to foster a culture of empowerment that promotes female strength and intelligence. Walls are decorated with motivational posters and messages that remind each young woman how unique, intelligent and valuable she is.
