2024 Outcomes

- 15 years old was the average age in 2024
- 6 hours of academic instruction provided daily
- 75 First Aid/CPR certificates awarded
- 95 youth earned a vocational certificate or job skill
- 10.5 hours of therapeutic services provided per youth each week
- 13 average family contacts per youth each month
- 920 family visits and home passes completed throughout the year
- 5.7 hours of PYD activities provided per youth each week
